

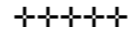

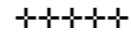

#### MISSION RECEIPTS

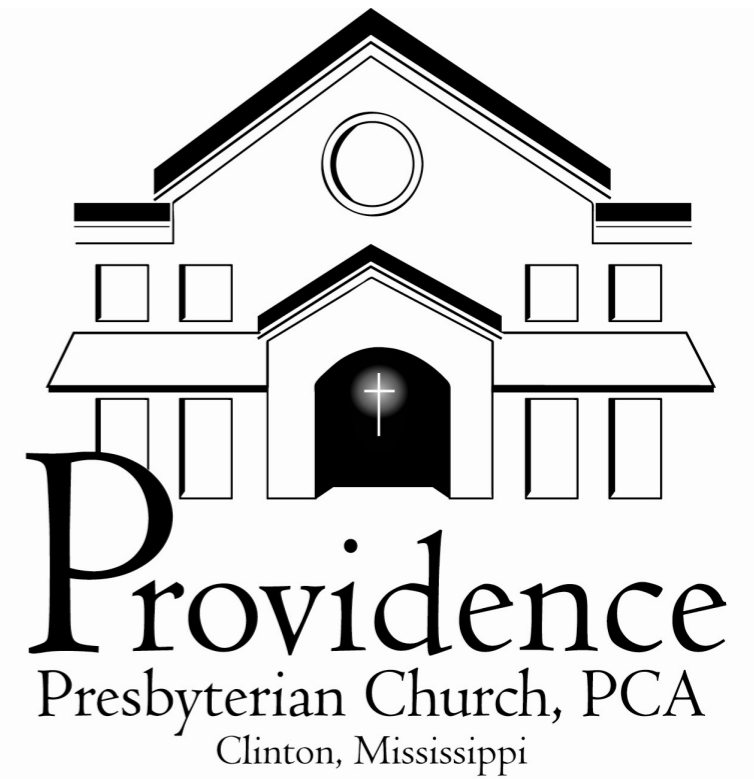
