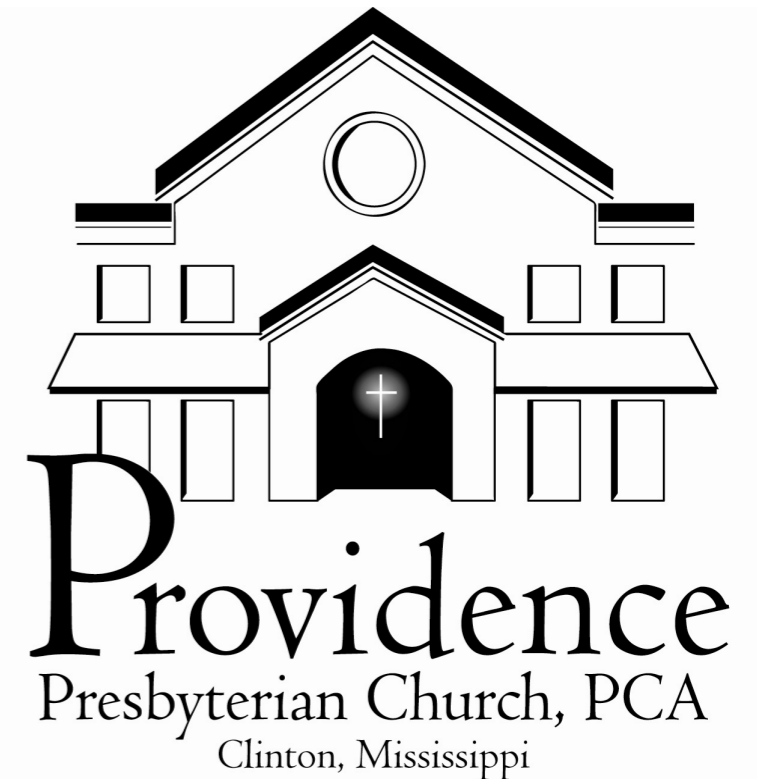
Please continue to pray for the Session as the search of an Assistant Pastor continues and hopefully comes to fruition in the near future.
