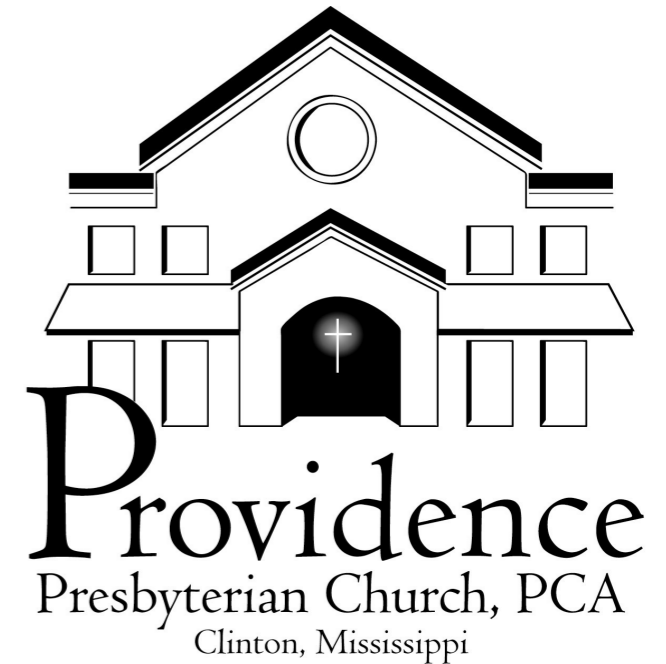

FALL ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL

Mr. Hal Martin will lead one of the Adult Sunday school classes offered this Fall on *Gospel in Life, Grace Changes Everything*. **Please sign up in the narthex for this class and book.** The class will include a Study Guide for use in class and for reading between classes, and a 10-minute video presentation by Tim Keller will begin each session. *Gospel in Life* is a study on the gospel and how it is lived out in all of life – first in our hearts, then in community, and out into the world.
