Thy tabernacles holy in pleasantness excel.

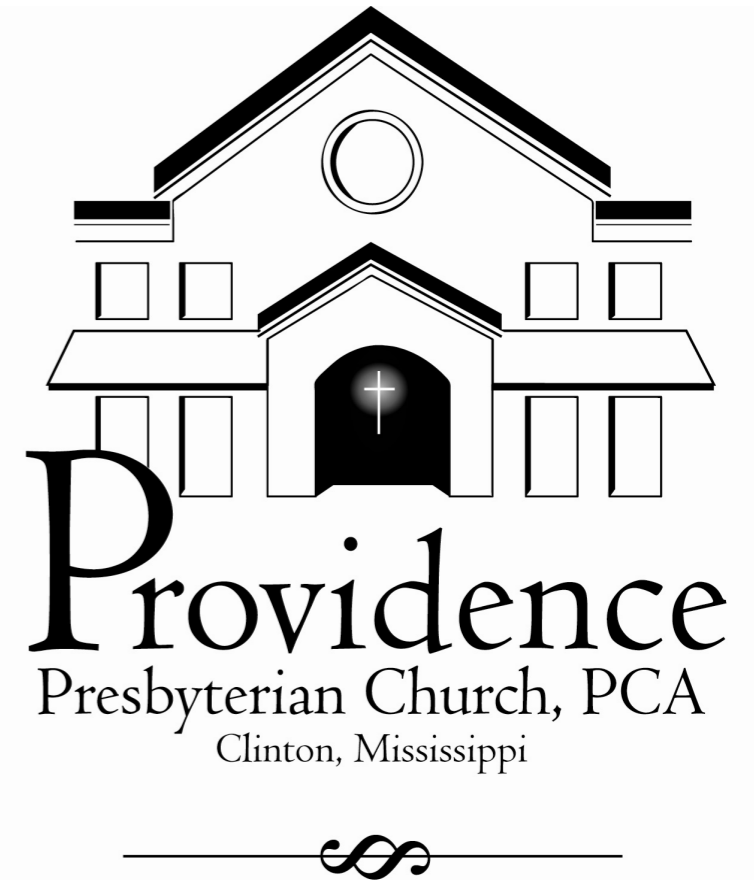
