FISH FRY

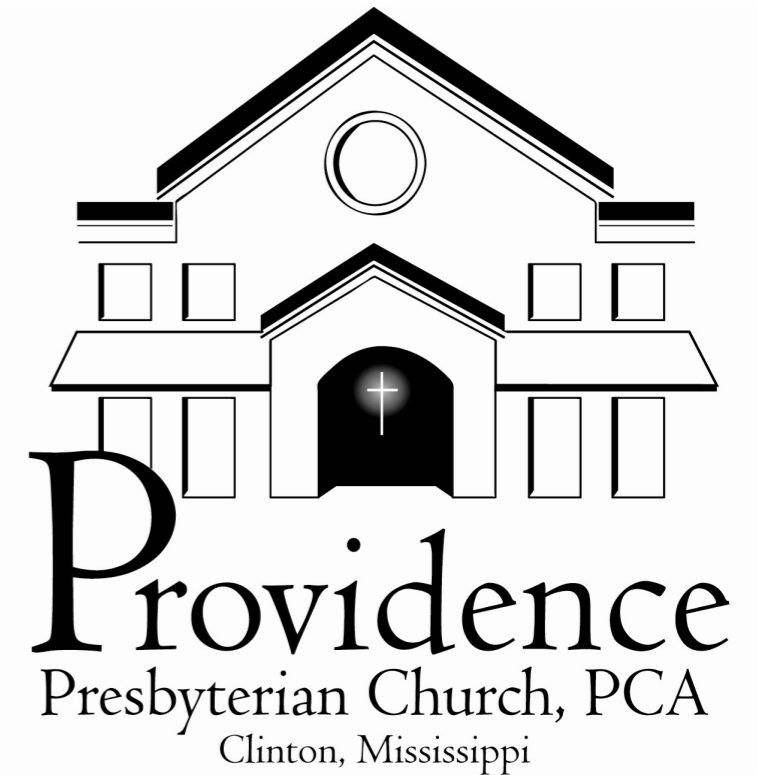
