Dear Church Family,

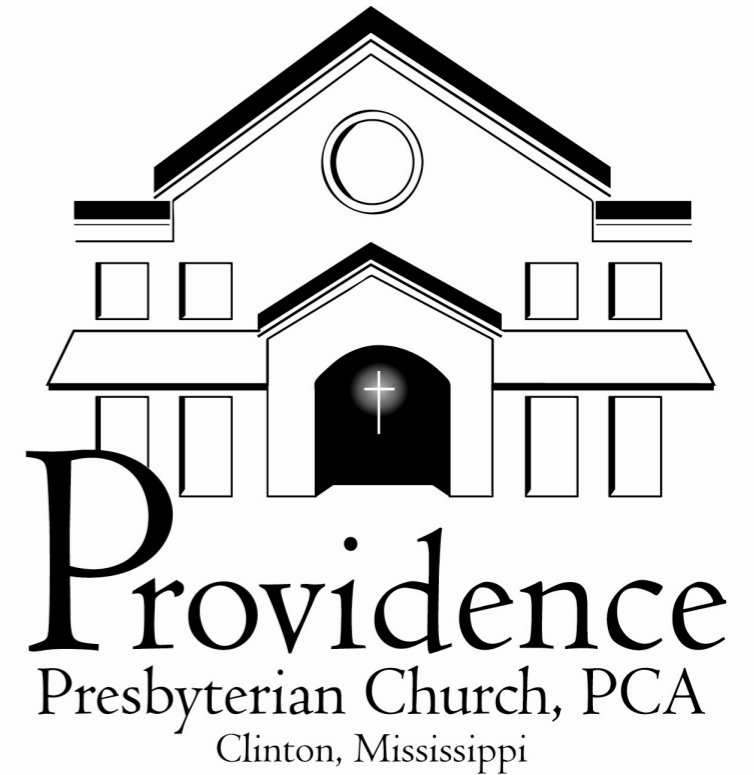
