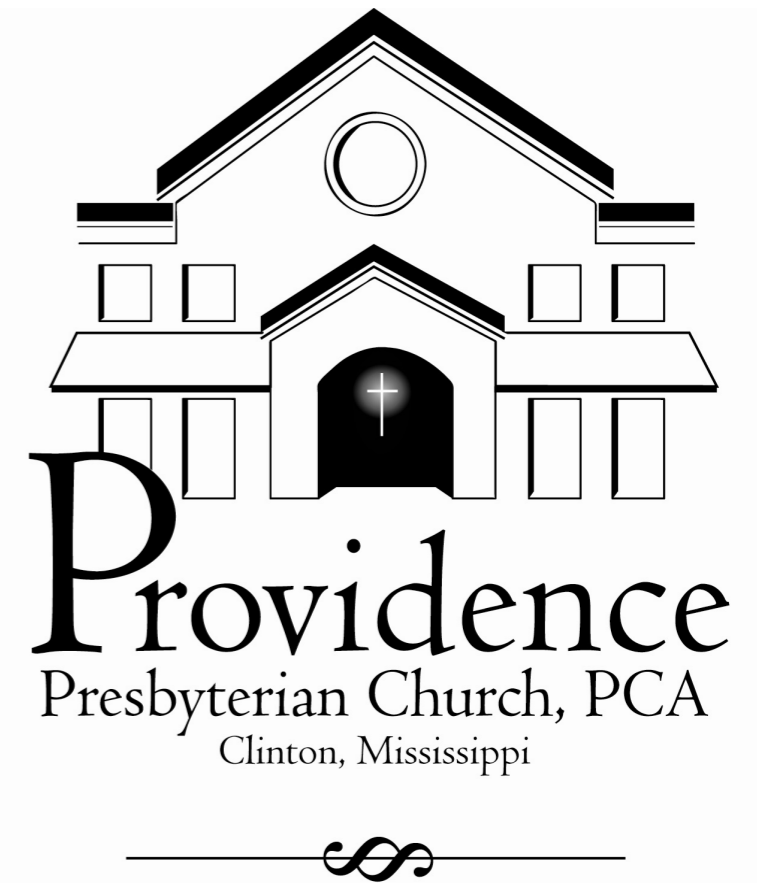
#### CHILDREN’S CHURCH
