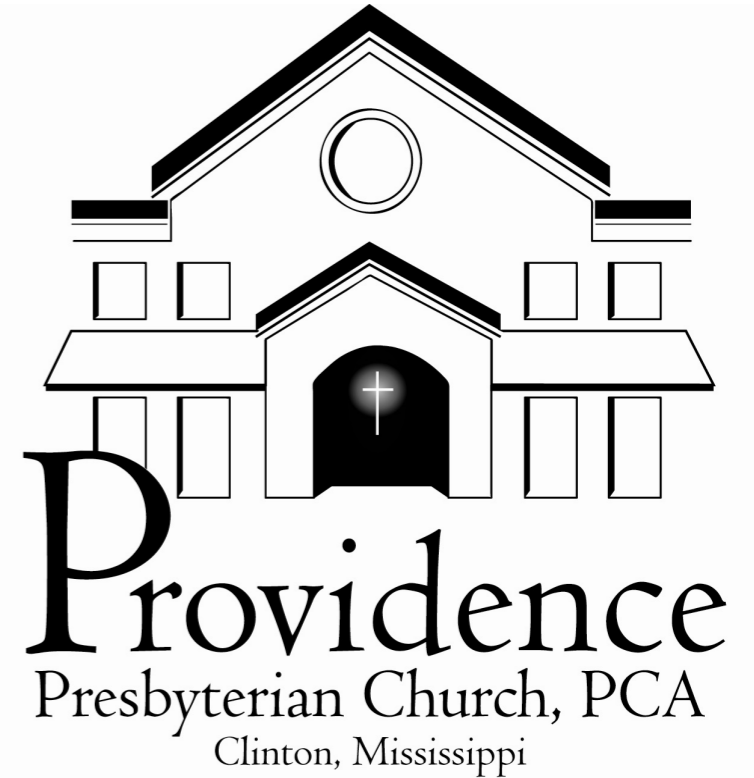
### SUNDAY NIGHT OPPORTUNITY
