*We would also like to thank the WIC for the gift cards to local restaurants. In this busy season, they will surely be of great help to us. Yum!*

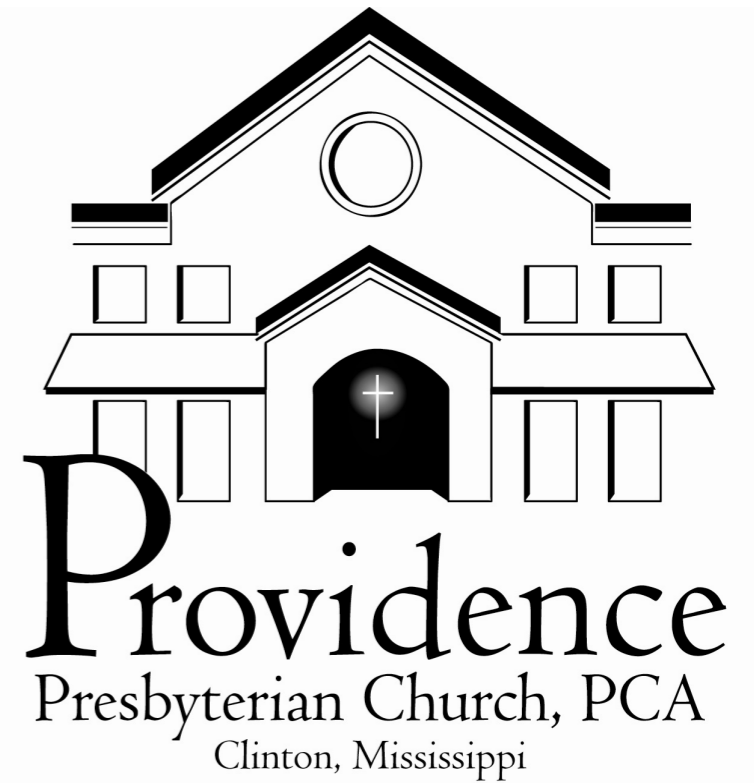
