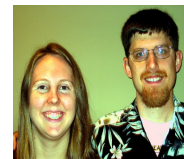
I also have a list of items for Don's unit if you wish to donate something. You can bring them to the church office or mail them yourself.

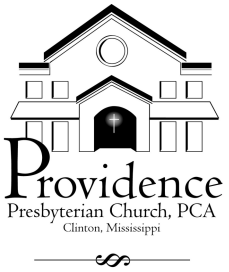
