For a world of lost sinners was slain.

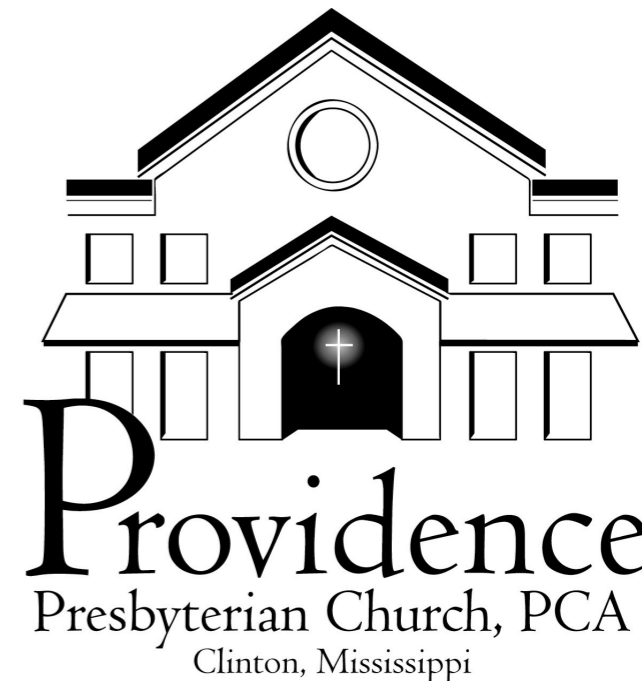
So I'll cherish the old rugged cross
