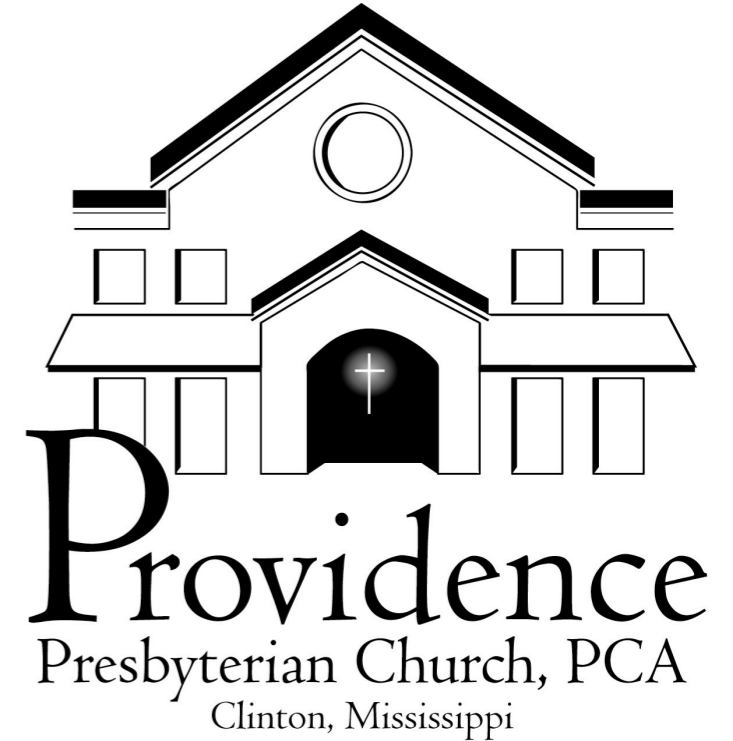
FALL ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASSES

1. “Bible 101 Survey” – This class will provide an overview of the Bible and was designed with visitors and new converts in mind. However, if you just need a review or you have always wanted to read through the Bible in a year, but bogged down in Leviticus, then you should enjoy this class. The class will be led by John Spears.
2. “Psalms” – taught by Brian Gault. When David was heartbroken, he used poetry to capture the depth of his pain before God's throne. When David longed for God's presence, he deployed the metaphor of “thirst” to express his longing to his God. That poetry, in the book of Psalms, was then given to the people of God to shape our worship today. In this class we will explore how to read Hebrew poetry (don't worry, we'll do it in English), investigate the types of Psalms, and think about what it means that these Psalms were put together in a book (that has an overall message). My hope is that by the end, the Psalms will become a voice that enables you to carry your emotions before the throne of God and a friend that carries you to Jesus.
3. “Jackie Chan Apologetics” – taught by Don Malin. Jackie Chan used everything available to defend himself against the enemy. Here we will learn to use everything available to defend our faith. Come to the Sunday morning Dojo and focus.
