Here in the love of Christ I stand

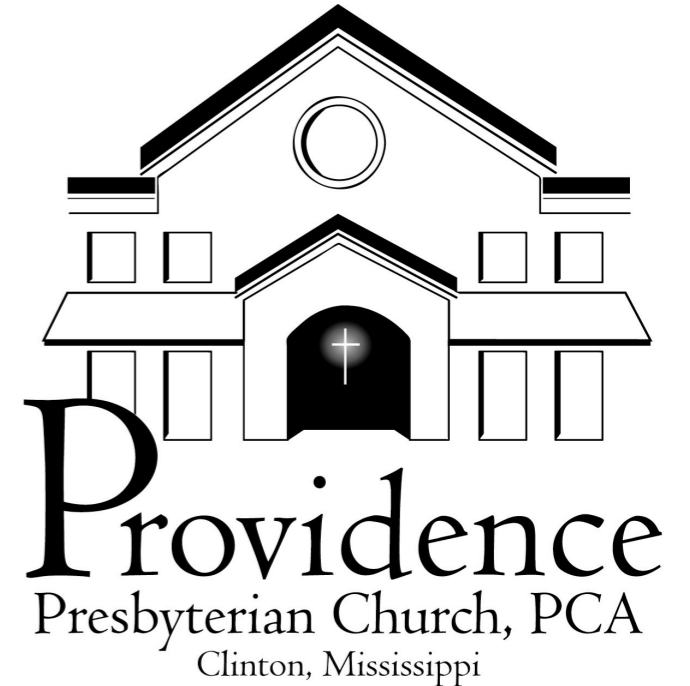
(2) In Christ alone, who took on flesh
