The session is thankful for God's provision for Providence through the tithes and offerings last year of \$502,461 (General - \$445,704; Building - \$10,025; Missions - \$46,732.)

Expenses totaled \$533,139 (General - \$294,221; Building \$7,367; Bond Debt - \$184,886; Missions - \$46,665.) The difference was covered by \$30,618 from savings and \$60.00 interest income.

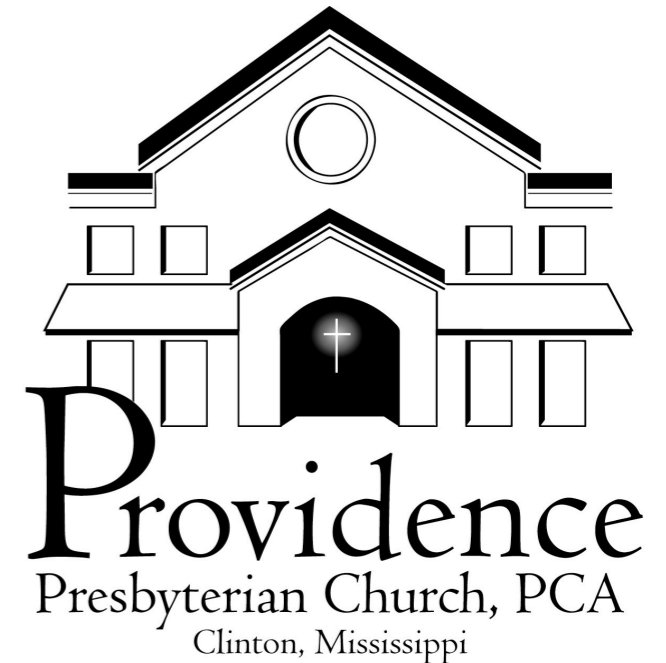
