 Righteousness,

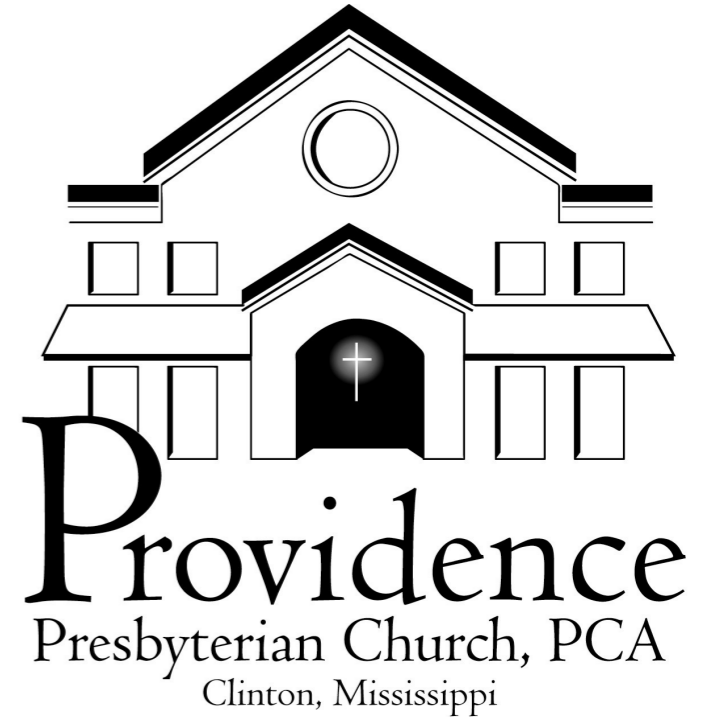
The great unchangeable I AM, the King of glory and of grace!
