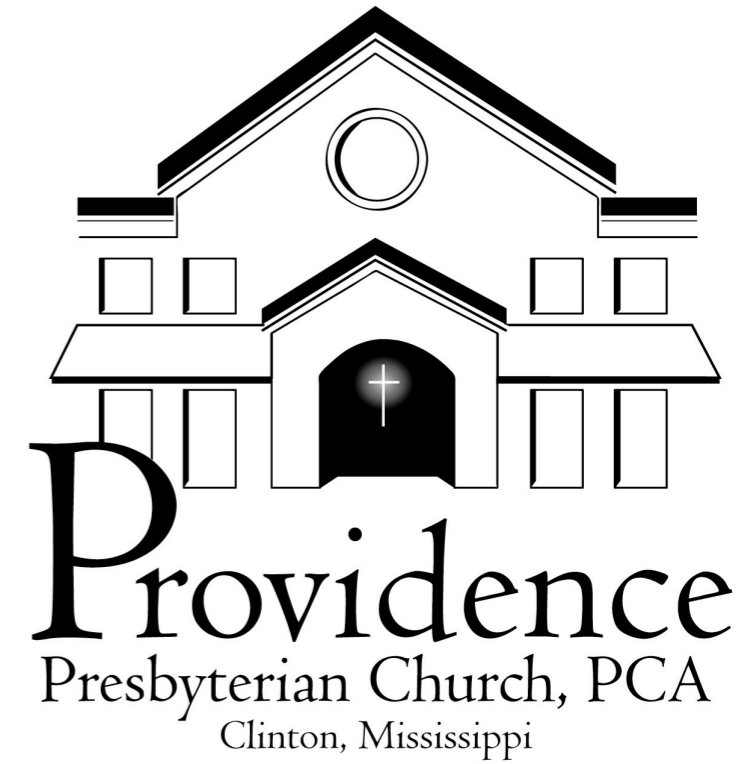
“The Solid Rock”
