But follow us through all our days with the certain hope of peace.

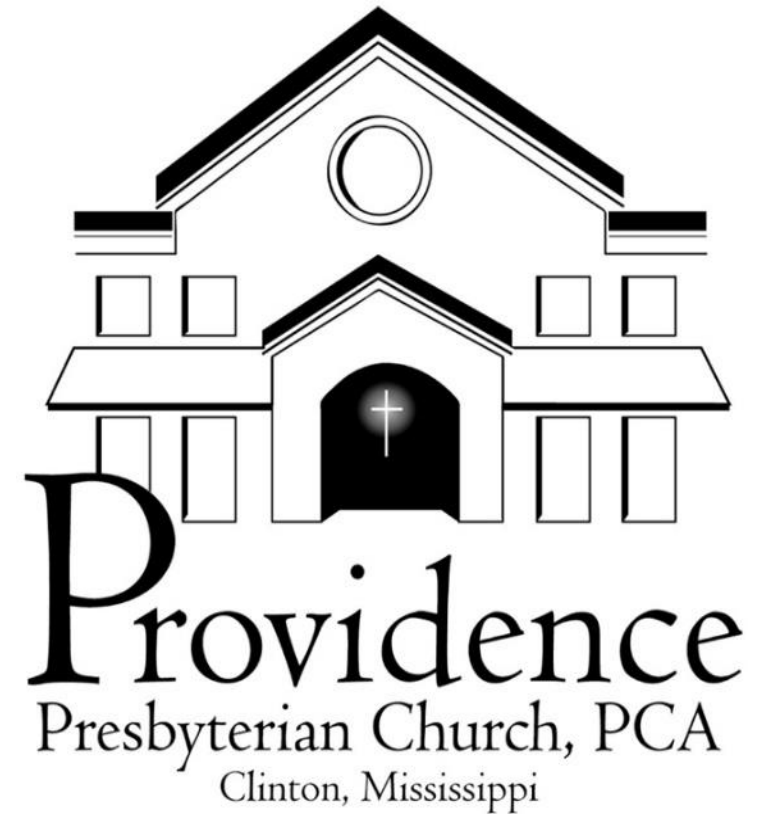
