### ASSISTANCE NEEDED

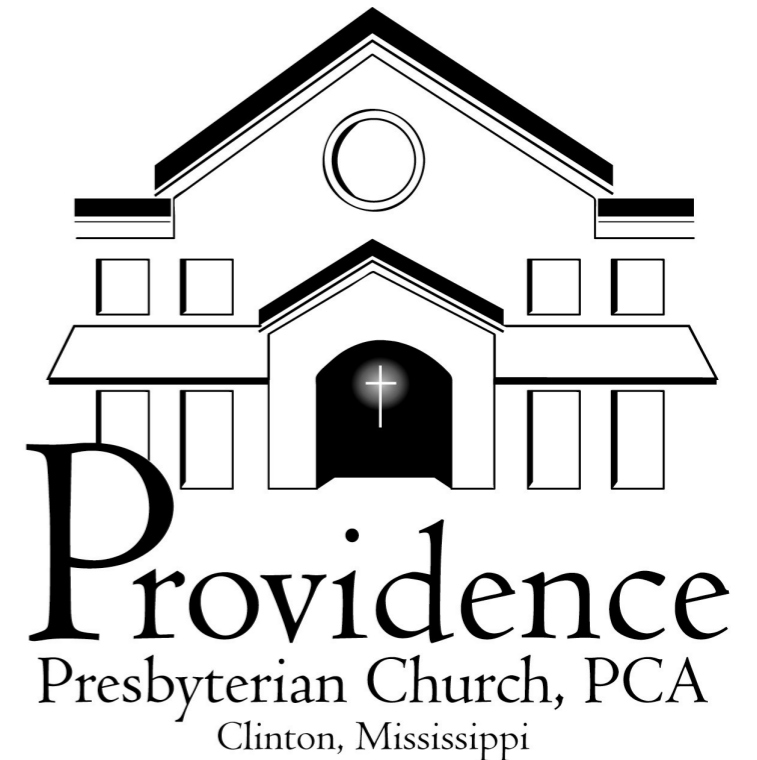
