 Hope of the hopeless, my Savior is He!

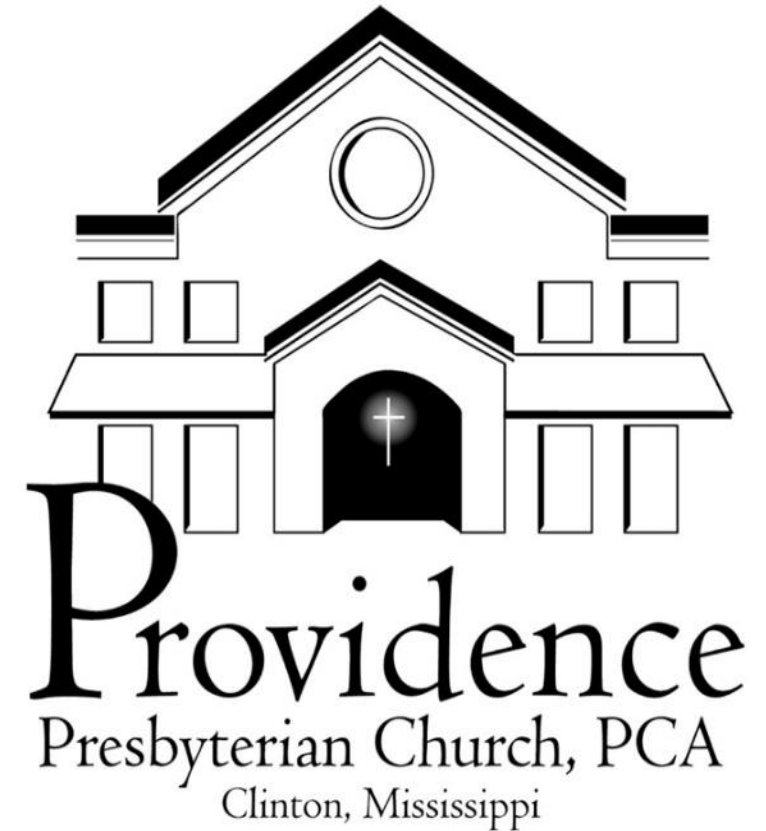
One day the grave could conceal Him no longer,
