"Before the Throne of God Above"

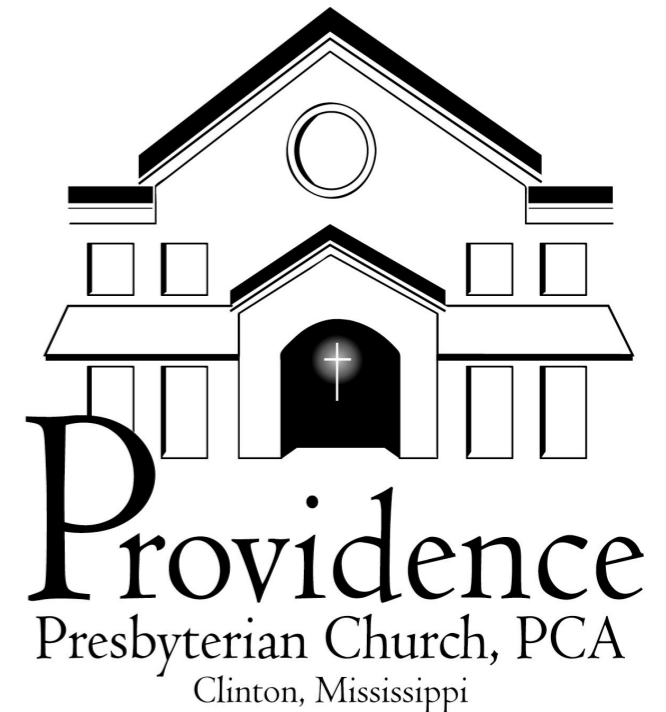
Choir Anthem
