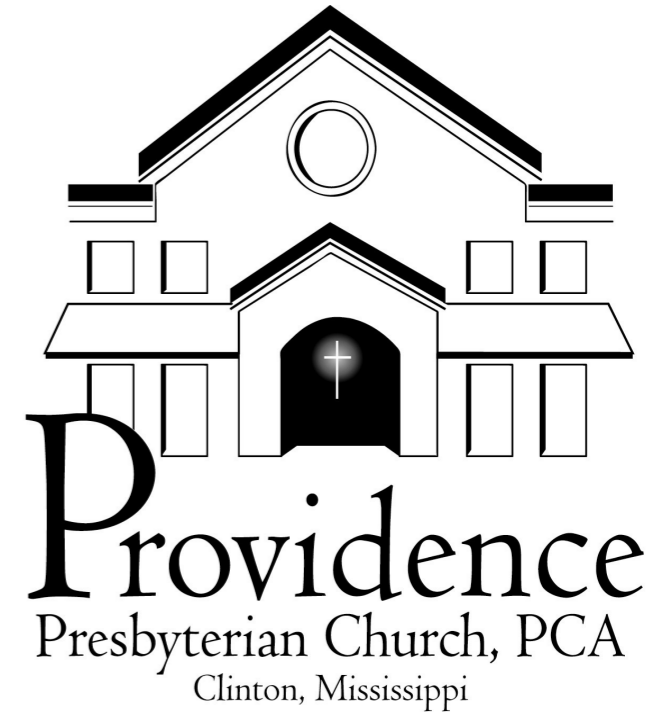
YEAR-TO-DATE BUDGET
