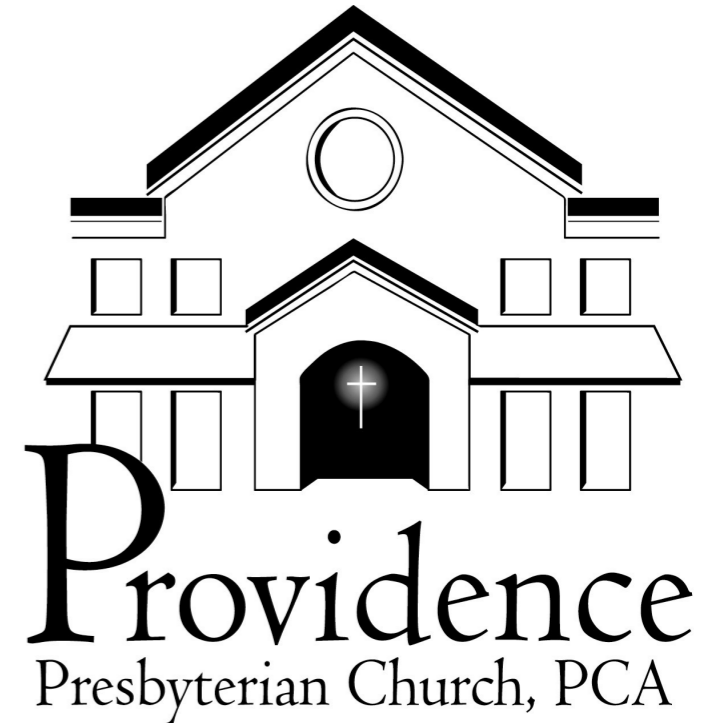
TRILOGY OF PRAISE
