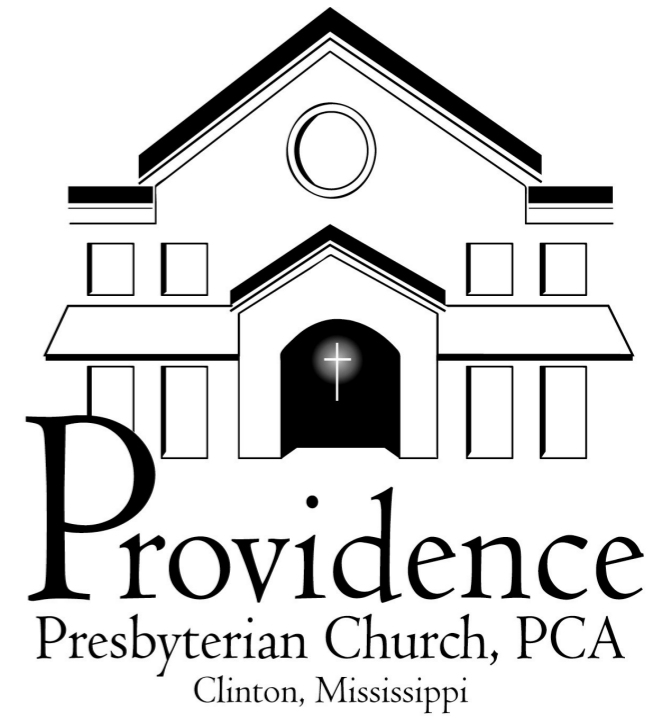

MISSIONS BUDGET UPDATE

Our missions budget is entirely dependent upon designated giving from our faithful, supportive congregation. No general budget funds go towards the funding of missionaries, foreign and domestic. Through November 2014, we have fulfilled all of our monthly commitments to our supported missionaries. However, as you have seen in the past few bulletins, the money we have sent out to our missionaries has exceeded the money we have taken in from you for our missionaries. We have continued to support our missionaries, in part, out of our committee's reserve fund (aka, the rainy day fund), but those reserves are being depleted. For this reason, we are making plans to cut funding to some missionaries and missions organizations beginning in December, and further cuts may be needed. We want you to be aware of the situation and thank you for all the financial and prayer support you have given to our PPC missionaries. In addition, we would ask you to give as each of you decides in your heart to give to the Lord's work of missions, for God loves a cheerful giver.
