Y-T-D as of 9/30/15: - (\$15,734)

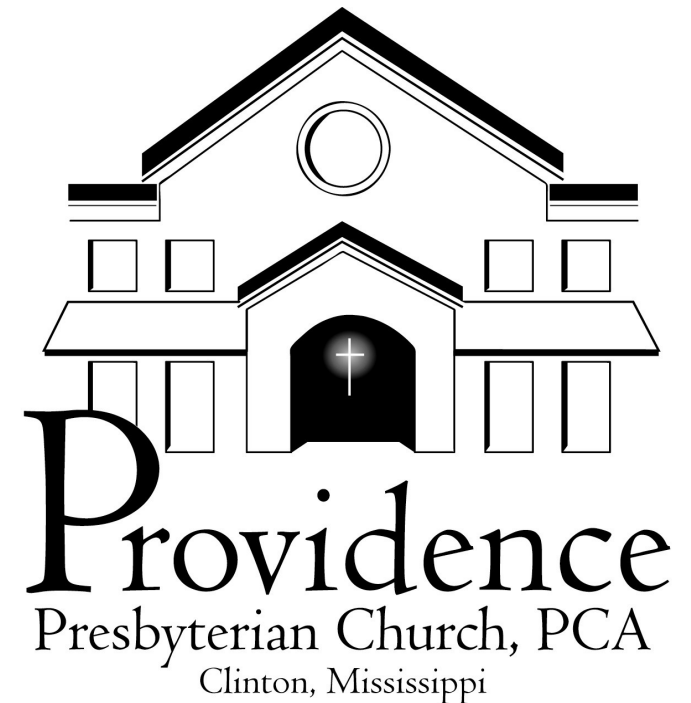
Please generously give to close the deficit for this year. Receipts beyond our required disbursements will allow us the opportunity to support General Assembly, Presbytery and other benevolences.
