And I stand on ev'ry promise of Your Word.

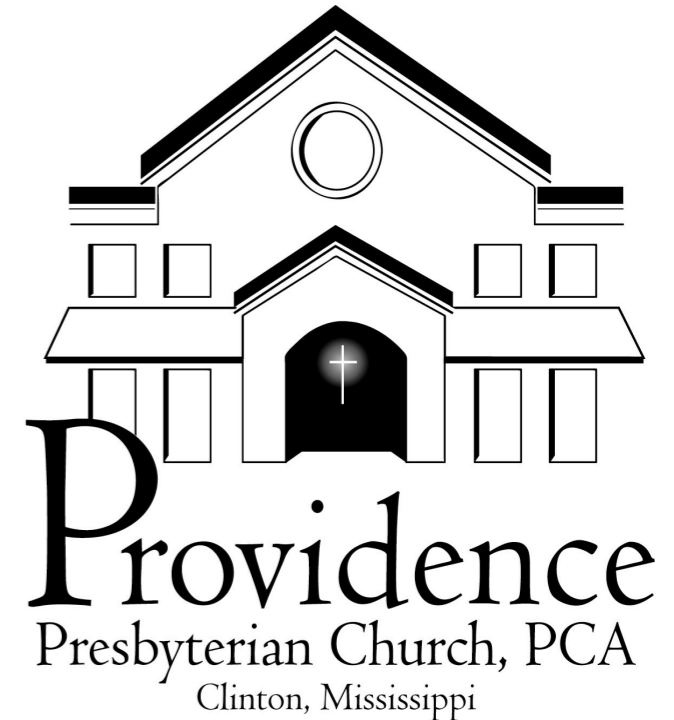
Grace sufficient, grace for me; Grace for all who will believe.
